☐ Must reside in Jefferson, Sumter, Pickens, Greene, Tuscaloosa, or Perry Counties.
☐ Must have a minimum overall GPA of 2.5 or higher.
☐ Application must be typed or printed in blue or black ink.
☐ Application and requested materials must be submitted electronically or via postal mail by
March 24, 2023.
 If by mail, materials must be submitted in ONE ENVELOPE and be postmarked by March
24, 2023.
o If by e-mail, materials must be submitted by 11:59 pm on March 24, 2023.

Applicants are responsible for having their academic records (UNOFFICIAL or OFFICIAL TRANSCRIPT) verified by Counselor. When submitting your application, please submit the following documents to be considered for the NCBW-Central Alabama Chapter Scholarship Award:

- 1. Completed application form.
- 2. Two letters of recommendation from your high school or college faculty and/or counselor/advisor **IN SEALED ENVELOPE.** Recommendation letters can also be emailed to info@ncbwcentral-AL.org.
- 3. Academic transcript
